Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your feedback from the letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 2015 regarding the changes we are piloting for breaking good learning habits.

The trial period last week was very successful and students appear to be much more focused in lessons as a result, however, it is with sadness, that I must report that some students have forgotten to attend their second break 30 minute compulsory learning sanction. From this week if any student misses the 30 minute compulsory learning session at second break they will immediately be issued with a 60 minute sanction that day at 3:15pm. We would ask for your support to encourage your son or daughter to attend their compulsory learning sanction during second break.

All staff have been told to inform students if they have been issued with a compulsory learning sanction and it is the responsibility of the student to attend the session at 1:30pm prompt in E05. It would be helpful if you could reiterate the following at home if you consider your son or daughter to be forgetful:

1. Compulsory learning sessions are at 1:30pm in E05
2. Failure to attend the 1:30pm 30 minute session will result in a 60 minute sanction at 3:15pm that same day.

I would like to remind you that changing the compulsory learning sessions to second break was intended to alleviate the issues raised by families regarding transport home and to acknowledge the efforts of the 98% of students who get it right daily.

I will write to you again at the end of the summer term to share the impact of the pilot and share the next steps.
