Art & Design Exhibition

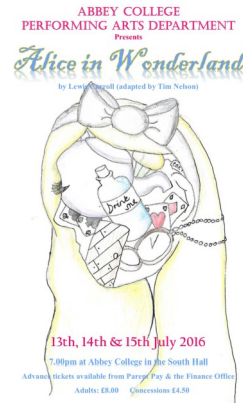

Also, to support the school play, Catering students had created snacks & drinks inspired by Alice in Wonderland.

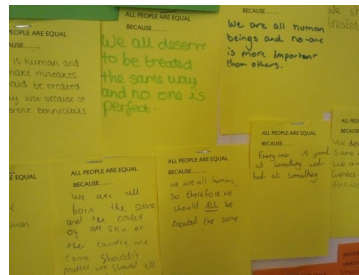
Well done to all of our Art & Design Technology students, for another fantastic year of talent & creativity!
