We have made a commitment to design a curriculum which closes both the academic and experiences gap for all students and especially for those who are disadvantaged.



Each student will benefit from a personalised mentor

- PASS survey to be completed 2 times per year to identify barriers and develop intervention.
- Having 3 dedicated tutor interviews per year.
- Attending a 1:1 parent meeting per year.
- Access relevant online revision resources.

Each student will benefit from financial support which will ensure:

- All experiences can apply for funding to remove the financial barrier.
- Funded music tuition is available.
- OOPs can apply for funding to remove financial barriers.
- CCF, DofE and sports leaders are funded to remove the financial barrier.

Each student will be supported to ensure attendance and achievement in line with their peers.

- Based on NGRT and CAT4 if underperforming in the basics will have access to small group tuition.
- Priority for Yr11 PAR sessions
- Each student will be supported to achieve at least 97% attendance.

Each student will have memorable experiences that will support engagement and grow independence:

- Completing the Abbey College SPIRIT personal development programme.
- Attending at least three off site 'experiences' trips by the end of Yr9.
- Experience a residential trip by the end of Yr11.
- Free access to Music or another specialist tuition.

Each student will have access to the best possible career guidance and as a minimum will:

- Attend at least 3 interviews with an independent career's advisor.
- Benefit from at least 5 different careers encounters.
- Complete at least one aspirational and high-quality work experience placement during Yr9 - Yr11.
